### Phase 1 – Closed-Stay at Home Order in effect

Library – Closed to all Staff – Only Director or designated staff allowed into building Director—Working from home as possible Circulation – Only digital content from Overdrive or MEL e-books Programs – None; sharing posts on Facebook of story times, virtual tours, etc. Returns – Book drop unlocked but patrons asked to hold on to materials. No one is scheduled to empty the book drop.

### Phase 2- Staff returns; no public access

Library – Closed to public Staff –Work at library with social distancing rules in effect, wearing masks Circulation – Digital content Programs – None; continue with Facebook sharing Returns – Only in book drop

#### Phase 3 – Limited patron services

Library – Building closed to public Staff – Work at library with social distancing rules in effect, wearing masks Circulation – Digital content and curbside service Programs – Only take and make projects; SRP digital only Returns – Only in Book Drops

### Phase 4 – Limited building access

Library – Open to public with limited hours or areas Staff – Work at library with PPE and social distancing rules in effect Circulation – Digital content, curbside and in-library Programs – Take & Make; online summer logging digital only Returns – Only in Book Drops Computers – Limiting # in use at any given time, disinfected between patrons

#### Phase 5 – Open with conditions

Library – Open to public with possible capacity limits Staff – Work at library with PPE and social distancing rules in effect Circulation – Digital content, curbside and in-library Programs – Consider small in-person programming outside, if allowed Returns – Only in Book Drops, consider reinstating return at circulation desk Computers – No appointment needed to use. Disinfected between patrons.

### Phase 6 – New Normal

All services & programming are offered Continue offering curbside pickup?

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
